# CANOE ISLAND FRENCH CAMP JOB DESCRIPTION: VOLUNTEER MAINTENANCE ASSISTANT

### **General Responsibilities**

To assist the Island Caretaker in effective maintenance of camp facilities and grounds to create an inspiring and safe environment for campers. Job will include janitorial, repair, and construction work.

## **Authority/Accountability**

The Maintenance Assistant will be in communication with the Island Caretaker and Executive Directors regarding the needs of the camp facility and program.

#### **Specific Duties**

- 1. Assist in maintaining camp cleanliness, sanitation, and waste disposal.
- 2. Assist with maintenance, upgrade and protection of entire facility and grounds.
- 3. Assist in maintenance of pool water quality monitoring program.
- 4. Assist in maintenance of camp vehicles and vessels.
- 5. Assist in maintaining/repairing/replacing program equipment, as needed.
- 6. Assist with general upkeep of trails and grounds.
- 7. Assist as needed in all aspects of Canoe Island French Camp.
- 8. Use personal and rest time appropriately, within guidelines established by the camp's personnel policies, staff manual, and pre-camp materials.
- 9. Encourage respect for personal property and camp equipment.
- 10. Foster a community of respect and kindness amongst fellow assistants, other staff, and campers.

#### **Essential Functions**

- 1. Physical ability to perform the job as outlined and to respond quickly and effectively to environmental and other hazards, per camp policies/procedures.
- 2. Physical ability to lift 50 pounds, using both hands.
- 3. Ability to use good judgment in all situations.
- 4. Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing with fellow staff, campers.
- 5. Ability to work with people from a variety of backgrounds.
- 6. Ability to accept and give supervision and guidance.
- 7. Ability to visually observe and assess camper behavior with regard to its appropriateness in view of safety, health (physical, mental) and its effect on others.

#### **Minimum Qualifications**

- 1. Should have previous experience as a CIFC camper.
- 2. Ability to work productively and effectively with other staff.
- 3. Be at least 17 years of age
- 4. Have a strong work ethic
- 5. Have clean personal hygiene.
- 6. Wear appropriate clothes when working: no shorts, no open-toed shoes; no jewelry that might present a health hazard, long hair tied back.
- 7. Use proper hand-washing techniques
- 8. Ability to speak English and preferably have an understanding of basic French.
